**ALTHOUGH THE FASTEST-GROWING COMMUNITY IN ALLEGANY COUNTY, FROSTBURG RETAINS THE SMALL-TOWN CHARM OF ITS PAST.** At the Princess Restaurant, a Frostburg tradition since 1939, look for the booth with a small brass plaque where Harry Truman and his wife Bess sat in 1953. Restaurants abound and right in this small town you can sample a taste of Mexico, Italy, France, Greece and China.

In addition, downtown Frostburg is home to Frostburg State University, which is a center for cultural events and progressive educational activities. Founded in 1900 with a student body of less than 100 students, the school expanded to a four-year teachers' college in 1934. In 1988, the college was designated a university, and today, enrollment reaches 5,400 students.

Frostburg is also one of America's most beautiful and expansive natural recreation areas. Enjoy the Great Allegheny Passage, a 150-mile, multiple-use rail-trail system that will soon connect Pittsburgh to Washington, D.C. The newly completed section of the Allegheny Highlands Trail links the City of Frostburg to the Mason-Dixon Line. From Frostburg, this trail leads to a long tunnel, which helps to ease the climb up the eastern face of Savage Mountain. Bikers and hikers are rewarded with spectacular scenic views of the surrounding mountain range. Frostburg is also a 15-minute drive from Savage River Forest and Dan's Mountain, where avid fisherman and outdoorsman will find peace and tranquility beyond compare.

Come enjoy the serenity and small-town hospitality of Frostburg, where you can explore historic sites, watch classic movies in the Palace Theatre, or take a walk along tree-lined, brick-paved Frost Avenue and enjoy the vintage Victorian homes.
