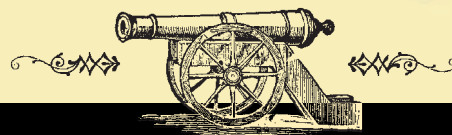


TANEYTOWN

TANEYTOWN'S HISTORIC DOWNTOWN DISTRICT OFFERS A DIVERSE MIX OF BUSINESSES, A RICH HERITAGE OF HISTORICAL BUILDINGS AND QUAIN ARCHITECTURE.

Established in 1754, Taneytown held the encampments of General Mead for his Northern troops during the Civil War and is now part of the Maryland Civil War Trails tour. Taneytown celebrated its 250th birthday in 2004 by depicting its rich history from the Revolution to the present. History buffs will love the Historical Museum and self-guided or guided walking tours of downtown. Taneytown's Main Street is dedicated to the commercial revitalization and historic preservation of the community.

Given the long history of rural settlement, the town and surrounding area is rich in historic landmarks that continue to enhance and affect the character of the area.

Visit unique shops, grab a bite to eat at the numerous downtown restaurants and don't forget to stop at Antrim 1844, an internationally recognized bed and breakfast. Built in 1844, Antrim was once a thriving plantation and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors can enjoy firsthand the exceptional restoration of this historic property.

Taneytown, a city of nearly 6,000 people, is a community that works together in spirit and pride.
